Type of Incident

(example: Slip-Trip, Fall from Height, Vehicle , Laceration, Chemical Exposure)

Summary:

An employee was walking adjacent to a forklift truck helping to stabilise a piece of equipment being transported.

During this task, the employees foot was jammed against the forklift trucks wheel when there was a change in direction, which resulted in the employee requiring hospital treatment.



Root Causes:

- Failure to follow correct procedure
- Improper use of equipment
- Risk assessment inadequate

Actions Taken Thus Far: Next Steps

- Review risk assessment & procedure for task
- Provide education and training for all employees in the importance of using the correct equipment for task, and the importance of forklift safety in the workplace
