<p>Summary of Incident</p> <p>An associate was preparing and loading finished products on to a goods-out truck with a forklift. During this task, it is necessary for the associate to gain access to the back of the truck to position the loaded goods, and repeat this process until all products have been loaded safely. During this process the associate complained of a sore back and sought medical assistance.</p>	<p>Critical Factors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Associate did not use the identified access platform to safely access and egress from the goods-out truck, opting to jump from the back of the truck to the ground level. • Inadequate supervision
